RE: Heacham Flood Defences

With regard to your query about taking vehicles and equipment across the shingle ridge, the Land Drainage and Sea Defence Byelaws state as follows:

28. Driving of animals and vehicles on sea defences

No person shall without the previous consent of the Authority take or drive or permit to be taken or driven any animal or vehicle of any kind whatsoever whether mechanically propelled or not on, over or along the sea defences except for the purpose of crossing the sea defences at or by any existing public or private pull-over or cart gap or at or by any other place for the time being authorised by the Authority

As you will appreciate the aim of this Byelaw is to prevent damage to the defences. However, recognised crossing points have been provided at various locations and access to the beach should be via these points.
